

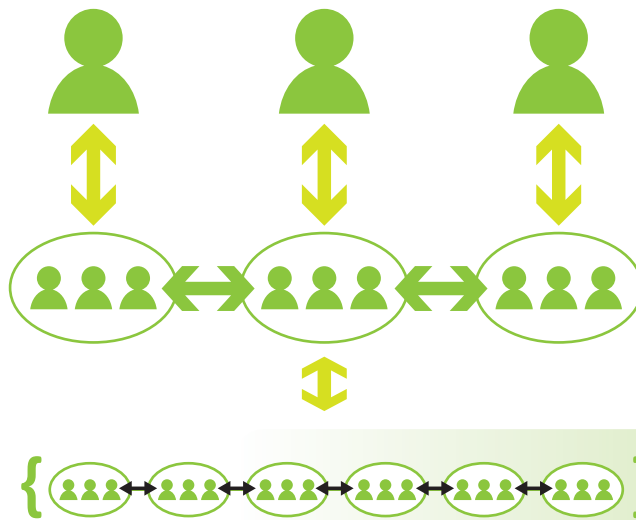
Community Landcare (on-ground works and community development)

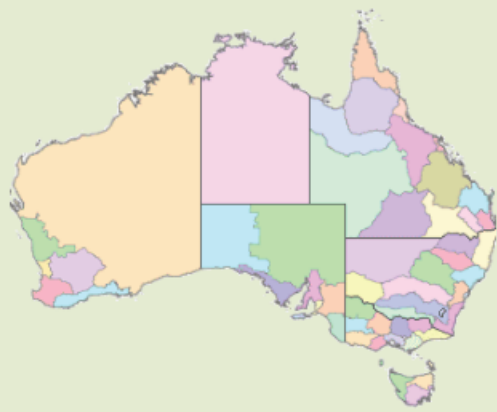
Provision of technical advice, funding and support for care groups

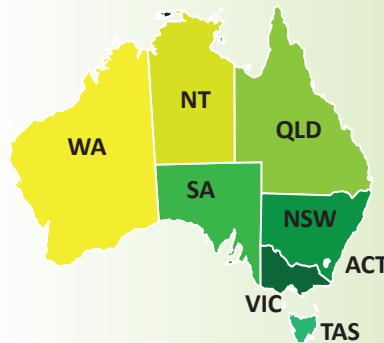
STATE
